

## VBA Macros in LuxTemplates product

The product or its variation is based on VBA scripts, sometimes called "Macro". You can recognize macro files by its extension:

**xlsx** -> these are normal Excel sheets

**xlsm or xlsb** -> these are with macros

## What is a VBA Macro?

Macro is an additional script that automates the work, it is written in the VBA programming language. Every application is made up of scripts, without them you would not be able to run any application.

Macros used in LuxTemplates products are created and/or tested by our team, it does not come from Microsoft company, so when you run the spreadsheet for the first time, a warning message may appear.

## Is it safe?

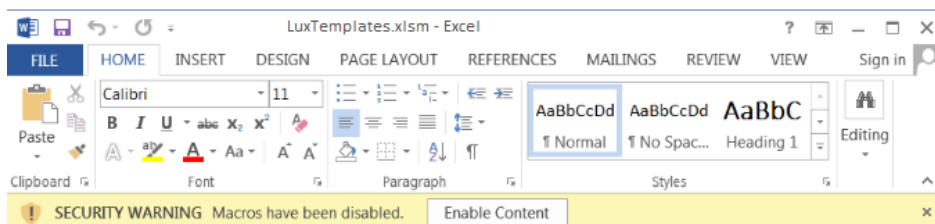
We declare that our spreadsheets are safe, do not interact with other applications installed on your computer, do not interfere with other files, or do not send data outside your computer. Your personal data is safe.

We declare that the application does not require an Internet connection, does not connect to our servers, and LuxTemplates does not store any of your data.

## How to enable macros to use spreadsheet? 1/2

During the first run, you can expect one of the following cases. It will be a red or yellow warning ribbon.

-> Yellow ribbon with "Security Warning" information

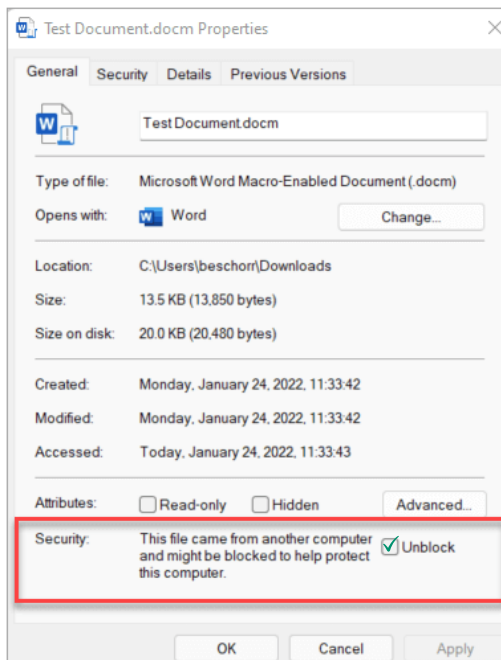
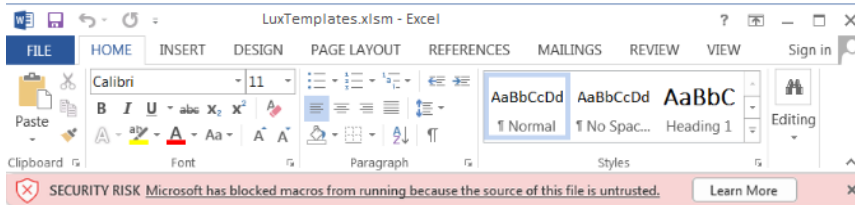


Just click on "Enable Content". That's all

## How to enable macros to use spreadsheet? 2/2

During the first run, you can expect one of the following cases. It will be a red or yellow warning ribbon.

-> Red ribbon with "Security Risk" information



In most cases you can allow macros by modifying the properties of the file as follows:

1. Open Windows File Explorer and go to the folder where you saved the file.
2. Right-click the file and choose Properties from the context menu.
3. At the bottom of the General tab, select the Unblock checkbox and select OK.
